



### **Preparation of your Paper Proposal for submission**

1. A brief abstract (maximum 500 words) must be entered into the text box
2. A document in the form of either an extended abstract (2 pages plus an indicative bibliography, clearly stating purpose, methodology and findings) or a full manuscript, must be uploaded in PDF format.
3. Before uploading your PDF file please:
  - a) When naming your file please use the surname of the first author in the author list as your file name (e.g. Smith.pdf, Carradine.pdf etc.).
  - b) Please carefully check your file for viruses, using the most current virus-checker, before uploading it to the abstract submission portal.

Note: Hard copy submission (by email, post or by fax) will not be accepted and proposals which don't comply with these instructions will be rejected.
